### Bed

- Pillows (atleast 1) + pillow case(s)
- Bed sheets + blanket set (At least 2) for twin XL
- Optional: Fleece Throw-for extra warmth, PA can get pretty frigid during the winter months.
- Mattress pad/foam-HIGHLY recommended if you want a good night's sleep.

### Inside The Closet

- Hangers (as many as you need)
- Hamper/laundry basket
- Detergent
- Dryer sheets
- Optional: bleach, for stains
- Optional: lint roller
- IRON + IRONING BOARD-who likes wrinkles?
- Slippers!
- SWIMSUIT + swim cap
- Flip flops/ Sandals
- Weather related
  - Rain coat/poncho
  - Rain boots/shoes
  - Umbrella
  - Hat, scarf, mittens
  - Winter coat

  - Sunglasses (optional)

### Bath & Bubbles

- Shower caddy
- Shower shoes
- Bath robe
- Shower cap
- Wash cloths
- Scrub brush/anything to wash body with

### Hygiene

- Tooth brush + floss + tooth paste
- Face wash, cleanser, body wash, etc.
- Deodorant
- Lotion/body moisturizer

- Towels (at least 2 )

#### Cleanliness

- Trash can + trash bags
- Broom, dust pan
- Cleaning spray (Lysol is cool)
- Paper towels
- Wet ones/wipes
- Cleaning rags (or fabrics you don't mind getting dirty)
- Hand held vacuum- All dorms have at least one vacuum, so this is optional.
- Duster

#### Study space

- Dry erase board + markers
- Calendar and/or planner
- Extension cord(s): Try to bring 2, you never know!
- Cushion for desk chair
- Command strips (required if you want to hang things on wall)
- Pens, pencils, markers, other writing utensils

#### Décor

- Lighting (standing lights, desk lamps, hanging lamps; some dorms don't get as much sunlight as others so proper lighting is a must)
- Potpourri/other scented things that don't require using fire/heat)
- Pictures, posters, etc. make it YOUR room
- Bean bag/small lounging furniture

#### Safety

- Flashlight (REQUIRED)
- Batteries
- Combination lock
- Good intentions

#### Important things

- Visa, ID, travel information
- Important medical info
- Medication
- Any important documents

#### Storage

- Storage bins/containers that can fit under bed/in closet
- Lock box

## Food/Kitchen

- Mini fridge
- Coffee mug(s)
- Tupperware
- Forks, knives, spoons, etc.
- Plastic/paper bowls, plates
- Water filter
- Water bottle
- Napkins
- Tea kettle
- SNACKS :) - Most dorms have vending machines but it doesn't hurt to bring things that are more your taste.

## Self-care

- Shampoo + conditioner + any hair products/tools that keep your mane proper
- Makeup
- Literature that makes you :D
- Personal journal/diary/notebook that is just for you :)

- Netflix subscription

## Electronics/Other

- Fan or portable AC (most dorms don't have AC and can get *very hot* during warmer seasons)
- Sewing kit
